

BAE Systems Silver Chairman's Award



The achievements of the HFI DTC serious games team have been recognised with a Silver BAE Systems Chairman's Award for Innovation. This award scheme aims to capture best practices, insights and innovative solutions within BAE Systems, and a Silver award comes as a result of successfully competing against other nominations at the national level. Led by Professor Bob Stone

of the University of Birmingham, and with contributions from BAE Systems, Cranfield University and Modux, the team has created a number of games-based Concept Capability Demonstrators under the HFI DTC research programme. *SubSafe* and *EODSim* were used as illustrative examples for the Chairman's Awards nomination, which was submitted under the 'Enhancing Customer Performance' category. *SubSafe* is an interactive 3D tool designed to improve the onboard spatial awareness of submariners, and *EODSim* supports classroom-based training of Explosive Ordnance Device threat assessment procedures – more information on these and other HFI DTC games-based simulation projects can be found in the Phase Two Training Research area of the HFI DTC website.
